Imagine Django Reinhardt and <u>Tom Waits</u> thumbing a ride with a carnival barker and other misfit circus acts to deliver a traveling revue of retro-cool mayhem and pyrotechnic wizardry — abundantly talented and refreshingly entertaining. There, in a nutshell, you have Caravan of Thieves.

The quartet, led by husband and wife duo Fuzz and Carrie Sangiovanni (vocals and acoustic guitars), has carved a niche with its unique blend of gypsy folk/rock and captivating live performances which have made them a staple in clubs and <u>festivals</u> throughout the U.S. and Canada.

Fresh off a successful summer <u>festival</u> season and a U.S. tour with the Tom Tom Club, the Thieves continue the journey into fall 2010 supporting its new live release "Mischief Night," follow up to their studio debut, "Bouquet."

The band is making a stop at the Brown Baer, 181 E. Rhine St. in Elkhart Lake, on Tuesday, Nov. 16, for a 9 p.m. show.
