A band whose frontman's name is "Fuzz" can't be half bad. Right? Right. On Sunday at 7:30 p.m., the Fuzz-led Caravan of Thieves will perform their acoustic tunes at the Town Crier Café at 130 Route 22 in Pawling, N.Y.

The Bridgeport-based acoustic group is fairly new, according to Fuzz, who got the nickname because his hair is fuzzy "or can be if it grows out." He and Carrie Sangiovanni, who plays acoustic guitar and provides vocals, have been together for a few years but the band itself only formed in March. Altogether, the group consists of Carrie, Fuzz, Benjamin Dean on violin and Brian Anderson on upright bass.

While the band is relatively brand spanking new, they already have a four song EP entitled "Live at the Art Space" out already. The EP was made before their first actual gig. "We do traveling rehearsals," Fuzz said. In other words, "since we don't use electricity or have a drummer, we play anywhere."

Sangiovanni and Fuzz describe their music best as "vocal harmonizing" with acoustic guitar "spanking, swinging driving gypsy rhythms fueling satirical and dramatic song writing." To cut to the chase, it's "an overall circus of sound."
