Fuzz may have made a name for himself with the jam-funk giants Deep Banana Blackout, but his lasting legacy may come from a more sophisticated place.

For the last few years, momentum has been building for the guitar player and his latest project, Caravan of Thieves. Fuzz and wife Carrie Sangiovanni have assembled an acoustic quartet that plays a raucous brand of gypsy-tinged folk-pop. They've gigged across the country in support of their debut album, "Bouquet," alongside everyone from Dan Hicks and Tony Trischka to Toad the Wet Sprocket.

Fuzz, Carrie and company embark on a month long East Coast tour Thursday night at Infinity Hall, playing with the Irish folk-pop duo the Guggenheim Grotto.
