Caravan of Thieves, the latest project from Deep Banana Blackout guitarist Fuzz, has made quite a name for itself on the local music scene in a relatively short period of time. Helping to flesh out the music even further will be Tom Tom Club's Bruce Martin, who will join in on accordion. Friday night's opening act is The Guggenheim Grotto, a folk-pop duo from Ireland. The Saturday night show may be more of a draw for fans of the local music scene as The Zambonis will play an all-acoustic set.
